We have an immediate need for a **Special Education Teacher** at the Agency's Bronx and Manhattan sites. The Teacher is responsible for the planning and implementation of all educational goals and objectives of the children assigned and for the overall classroom management and safety.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Formulates and implements the goals of the I.E.P. for each child by planning and providing instruction on developmentally appropriate activities.
- Responsible for the classroom management and ensuring a safe and appropriate classroom environment.
- Responsible for the supervision and direction of the Teacher Assistants and One-to-one Paraprofessionals assigned to the classroom.

QUALIFICATIONS:

A Master's degree in Special Education or equivalent degree preferred. Candidates currently enrolled in a Master's degree program in Pre-School Special Education with the appropriate certification may apply. New York State Certification in Special Education or Students with Disabilities (birth-3) required. Certification is required at the time of application. The candidate should be versed in the Common Core Standards.
